

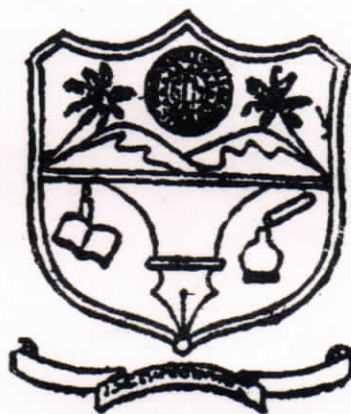

## **YEAR OF REPORT 2008-09**

### **PART A**

The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC at the beginning of the academic year towards quality enhancement and the outcome achieved at the end of the year. The meeting of the IQAC held on 27.06.2008 resolved to initiate proper and concrete measures to implement the following programmes in the college.

- 1) Reporting the vacant posts in the teaching faculty and non teaching faculty and the creation of new posts.
- 2) “Add-on” Courses.
- 3) Additional courses for the college – U.G. & P.G.
- 4) To promote open source software in the college.
- 5) Computerisation of college library.
- 6) Interdisciplinary programmes.
- 7) Generation of internal resources.
- 8) Seminars and workshops.
- 9) Office renovation.
- 10) Expansion of Internet facility.
- 11) Publication division.
- 12) Repairing and maintenance of college buildings.
- 13) Forming cluster departments.
- 14) Outreach programmes – Seed and sowing programme, RP for SCERT, RP for Seminar etc.
- 15) NET coaching.

- 16) Coaching for competitive examinations.
- 17) Lecture series – Economics.
- 18) Maintenance of play ground and construction of canteen building.
- 19) Proposal for Gallery and a mini pavilion for the college ground utilizing M.P.'s fund and PWD Fund.
- 20) Using student union as the forum for outreach programme- Blood Group Testing Programme, Eye testing Campaign, Journalism Workshop, Youth Against Liquor and other intoxicants etc.
- 21) Well preservation of college auditorium with collapsible grills, coumpound wall for auditorium on all sides and furnishing.
- 22) Tiling the audio visual room, seminar hall, inflibnet lab, girls room and college office.
- 23) Malayalam computing programme to be launched in this college using UNICODE System.
- 24) Utilizing internal resources and potential of other government colleges for the academic and non academic betterment of the college.
- 25) Motivating the final year students to undergo Career Placement; the Annual Placement Programme organized by Career Guidance and Placement Cell.
- 26) Motivating the teaching faculty to undergo research leading to M.Phil./Ph.D.
- 27) Submitting a detailed proposal for the construction of a new library complex under the U.G.C. scheme.
- 28) Motivating parents to curtail the percentage of drop outs in the college.
- 29) Preparation of database of the students year wise and discipline wise.



### **OUTCOME ACHIEVED**

- 1) The vacant posts in the teaching and non teaching category in the college were reported in time and was responded positively by the Government. The retired vacancies in the departments of Arabic, Commerce, History, Urdu and Chemistry have been filled up. New recruits have been appointed to the vacant posts of the college office.
- 2) In the light of the proposal for starting "Add-on" Courses, the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Government of Kerala has sanctioned an amount of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) for starting of "Add-on" Course in Spoken English and as such the course has been started successfully.
- 3) To cater to the higher educational needs of society, applications for starting new courses at the post graduate level in Mathematics and English have been submitted to the University.
- 4) The college during this academic year onwards has shifted to open source operating system like Linux, Fedora and UBUNTU, so that any information can easily be uploaded and downloaded without incurring any additional expenses.
- 5) Computerization of the library had already begun with library automation and free KOHA as software. By the end of 2009 this academic year, it is strongly proposed to finish the computerization.

- 6) In an age when the boundaries between various disciplines are blurring, interaction among the members of faculty of different disciplines has already begun. A forum for interaction has already been set up with the members of various faculties indulging themselves in exchanging ideas and new methods on the first Saturday of every month.

- 7) A) Inlibnet usage and the generation of resources.

Donations from various institutions for providing facilities for various programmes.

Getting rent from auditorium, seminar hall, audio visual room, class rooms etc.

- B) Using the internal resources of the faculty for PSC examinations, SCERT, Higher Secondary, VHSE, National and International Seminars, Trainer in workshops and University Board of Examinations, Restructuring of Undergraduate courses at University level.

- 8) A) All the departments providing undergraduate courses have conducted seminars and debates in their domain. An amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) was approved and sanctioned by the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Government of Kerala to conduct a one day seminar in Physics. Accordingly, a one day National Seminar on "Cosmology" was held on 5.11.2008.



- B) The Postgraduate Department of Commerce has conducted a Two-Day Seminar on “Employees Engagement in HR practices” generating fund by sponsorships from Banks and Businessmen. Seminars and debates organized by other departments by mobilizing their own resources from outside are mentioned in Part B.
- 9) The computerization of the college office by installing six more systems has already begun. With its renovation, the office has become more spacious and got a new momentum in its activities.
- 10) The expansion of the Infilbnet was done under the Special Development Scheme for MLA's – 2007-08 by utilizing an amount of Rs.4.1 Lakh from the fund of the Local MLA Advocate M. Ummer. Under this scheme an additional 16 systems were installed and the inauguration of the expansion of the Lab was done by the MLA himself on 3.11.2008. The scheme also provided an LCD Projector and a Lap Top. Students can avail themselves of this facility from 8.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. The students at the postgraduate level have been provided with Smart Class Rooms with all modern facilities.
- 11) The long cherished dream of setting up of Publication Division was materialized during this academic year. This Division has brought forth two academic journals ; one by the Department of Malayalam and the other by the Department of Arabic

A) The department of Malayalam has brought forth its quarterly journal, 'MALAYANMA', the first issue of which was released on 11.11.2008. This journal has been acting as the forum for fostering creativity exclusively to the college community.

B) The Department of Arabic released its first issue of the quarterly journal, 'ADEEWAN'. on 17.03.2009. This journal has been envisaged as the forum for the diffusion of knowledge, for acquainting the students themselves with the new methods and approaches emerging in the study of languages and literature, particularly in Arabic and fostering creativity exclusively to the college community.

- 12) As per the proposal of the College Council the PWD, Government of Kerala has come forward for the repairing and maintenance of college buildings with painting and false roofing.
- 13) The P.G. departments of Commerce and Economics have already mooted the idea of cluster departments, so that the students and teachers alike will get an opportunity to acclimatize with the latest methods and trends in various disciplines.
- 14) The outreach programme of the college was executed through various fora – Nature Club, Tourism Club, Students Union, National Service Scheme, National Cadet Corps, Staff Council and the like. The details are given in Part B.
- 15) The P.G. departments of Commerce and Economics have been providing coaching and guidelines to the students preparing for NET.

16) The faculty in the Department of Arabic has initiated a novel programme of setting up a coaching centre to provide academic training for competitive examinations, NET etc. The utilization of internal resources, especially knowledge base for the society has been noteworthy.

17) The P.G. Department of Economics has begun lecture series – Table Talk. The first of this years was given by Dr. V. Shanthakumar of the Centre for Development Studies, Thiruvananthapuram on “Financial Crisis and Market Failure” on 22.10.2008.

The second talk on the series was given by Sri. K.K. Damodaran, HOD of Commerce, PTM Government College, Perinthalmanna on “ Financial Crisis and Indian Economy” on 31.10.2008.

The third talk on the series was rendered by the Principal himself on ‘Stock Exchange Operations’ on 16.12.2008.

18) The proposal of the College Council fetched the setting up of a new canteen and the expansion and maintenance of college play ground. Fulfilling one of the dreams of the college, the newly built canteen was inaugurated on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2009 by Mrs. Hafsath Kiliyamannil, Vice-President, PTA.

19) The college approached the Hon’ble Member of Rajya Sabha and our Alumnae Sri.A.Vijaya Raghavan and the Hon’ble Member has proposed a gallery and a mini pavilion to the play ground by using M.P. LAD Scheme. The construction work of mini-pavilion and gallery as well as filling and expanding the ground with red soil is in process at a war-foot level.



20) The students union, the democratic body of the students actively participated in all the outreach programmes of the college. The Union organized an Anti Terrorist Rally from the college premises to Malappuram Town incorporating all the students and faculty on 04.12.2008. The Union also endorses its social commitment by supporting the ongoing struggle against liquor organized by 'Madhya Nirodhana Samithi' in front of the Collectorate, Malappuram.

21) The college auditorium has been well preserved with collapsible grills on all sides. Further, the furnishing of the auditorium has been initiated with support of the Alumni Association.

22) The PWD, Government of Kerala has already completed the tiling of Girls room and steps have been taken for the tiling of the college office, audio visual room, seminar hall, and Infilibnet Lab.

23) The steps for installation of Malayalam Computing Programme, 'UNICODE' has been in the offing. Selected students of the Malayalam Department attended the one day workshop at the Conference Hall of the Collectorate on 15.10.2008 conducted by 'Akshaya'.

24) The College strongly thinking of using the resources of other government colleges, so that the students can further their academic excellence. Steps have already been taken to get the resources from other government colleges.

25) The Career Guidance and Placement Cell has been entrusted with the responsibility of channelizing the students to take up career by undergoing the various placement interviews to be organized by various institutions at the campus at the end of the academic year.

26) In accordance with the action plan almost all members of the teaching faculty have started registering for research leading to M.Phil./Ph.D.

27) The college has already submitted a detailed proposal for setting up of a library complex by utilizing the UGC fund.

28) Students dropouts have been a major problem of anxiety for the college. To eliminate this pitfall, steps have already been taken to motivate the parents than the students, for, 70% of the students of this college is the first generation graduates of the families concerned.

29) The college with its proper support of the Inlibnet lab has already set up the database of the students year wise and discipline wise. This enables the college to get the minute details of every student for ready reference and further use.

## **PART B**

**New academic programmes initiated (U.G. & P.G.) :**

- i) To cater to the higher educational needs of society, applications for starting new courses at the post graduate level in Mathematics and English have been submitted to the University. On 19<sup>th</sup> March 2009, Calicut University Syndicate Committee consisting of Dr.K.K.Balachandran (Chairman) and Dr.Babu Ibrahim(member) inspected the college and convinced thm with the infrastructural and other facilities available here for starting these two PG Courses.
- ii) In the light of the proposal for starting “Add-on” Courses, the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Government of Kerala has sanctioned an amount of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) for starting of “Add-on” Course in Spoken English and as such the course has been completed its 100 hours package for the year successfully.
- iii) College organised a 30 Hour Certificate Course in MS Word to the outgoing selected 50 students on a nominal fee of Rs.100/- only for the course This has been organized under the supervision of Dr. Sulaiman, Co-ordinator, INFLIBNET Lab.

**Improvements in the Library Services :**

The computerization of the library moved a step further towards total computerization. Steps are being taken for library transactions such as issue and research by using Linux based Software – KOHA. There have been 35,208 issues, which is 800 more than last year. Besides it is worthy to note that there have been 22,006 visits to the library by readers this year, which is 500 more than last year. 650 new books have been added to the library this year and periodicals have been continued to. Purchase of books of this year can be broadly classified under two heads:

**Computerisation of Administration and the Process of Admissions and Examination results, issue of certificates :**

The softwares pertaining to computerized admission to the U.G. and P.G. courses was modified and made more user friendly. Linux based softwares were used for this purpose. The results of the internal evaluations are computerized in all the departments. It is highly commendable that our college became the pioneer in the first year University Examination Online Registration.

**Increase in infrastructural facilities :**

As already noted the Infflibnet Lab was expanded by installing 16 systems, a lap top and a LCD Projector. An amount of Rs.2,50,000/- have already been allocated for the computerization of the office and its renovation.

**Technology upgradation :**

From this year onwards our college switched over to open source software partially. Linux, Fedora and UBUNTU which can provide any information to the college community without any additional financial commitment.

**Computer and Internet Access and Training to Teachers and Students :**

Teachers and students have been well provided with Internet facility, use of computer systems free of cost. All the faculty of this college has been provided IT Mission Training through Akshaya free of cost. The college has become the centre of computer literacy.



College organised a 30 Hour Certificate Course in MS Word to the outgoing selected 50 students on a nominal fee of Rs.100/- only for the course. This has been organized under the supervision of Dr. Sulaiman, Co-ordinator, INFLIBNET Lab.
